SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Over 100 years ago, our church was given the name Sacred Heart of Jesus. On Friday, June 15, we celebrate our titular feast – The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. So that more of our parish family might be able to attend our celebration, Mass has been moved to 6:30 p.m. We will rededicate ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus with a pray of Consecration during the Mass. After Mass, we will continue our celebration with an Ice Cream Social in the Lower Church. Please plan to attend Mass and stay for the social as we celebrate our patron feast.

FUNERAL SERVERS

We are looking for a small group of adults (male and female) who are generally available in the morning and who would be willing to be trained and serve occasionally at the altar for funerals. Normally, two servers are used for a funeral Mass. During the summer it is difficult to find servers available from among our regular altar servers, during the school year it is not always appropriate to be pulling them from class.
